


KA'BA Islam Project



The cube will represent the Ka'ba, the holy site in Mecca that Muslims make pilgrimages to each year. The Ka'ba is a symbol of unity for Muslims around the world. Each year on a specific date indicated by the Islamic calendar, Muslim people will journey from all reaches of the world to this sacred place to worship together. The pilgrimage can last several weeks, with many activities, but will always include walking around the Ka'ba seven times and praying. They do this in the same way in order to recognize the idea that Allah sees all people as the same. No matter the nationality, cultural background, economic status, man or woman, Sunni, Shiite, or Sufi, they all come together as the same under the eyes of Allah.

On your cube you should include words and drawings that reflect the various aspects of Islam that we have covered. Design is very important! Points for creativity...always!






Cube Template




SIDE 4:TILE GEOMETRIC FLORAL DESIGN






SIDE 1: MAP OF THE
